

CLOVIS EAST ADVANCED PLACEMENT PROGRAM AND TESTING SCHEDULE

The Clovis East Advanced Placement (AP) Program is offered at the Reagan Educational Center as the most widely accepted college-level academic program available to high school students. The AP College Board allows students to take an approved exam for each enrolled subject offered in order to put into practice what students have learned. This cooperative program allows colleges and universities to acknowledge and provide credit for the college level work being completed in high school. The CEHS AP program helps to prepare students for the rigor and level of academics expected in post-secondary education. Current AP Course offerings include: Biology, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Physics 1: Algebra-Based, Chemistry, English Language & Composition, English Language & Literature, Environmental Science, European History, French Language and Culture, US Government and Policy, Macroeconomics, Psychology, Spanish Language, Statistics, Studio Art: Drawing, U.S. History, and World History.
