#### CUSD Requirements Cont...

- 2 years of Science:
  - 1 year Physical Science1 year Life Science



- 2 years of either Foreign Language <u>OR</u>
   Visual/Performing Art <u>OR</u> Career Technical
   Education (or combination of 2 out of 3 areas)
- 4 years of Physical Education
- Total of 230 credits minimum!!!!!

# What Are The Requirements For A CSU or UC?



- 4 years College Prep English
- 3 years of Social Science:
  - World History
  - U.S. History
  - Govt./Economics
- 3 years Math required (4 years recommended)

### CSU/UC requirements cont...

- 2 years of Science (3-4 years recommended)
  - 1 year Life Science (Biology)
  - 1 year Physical Science (Chemistry)
- 2 years Foreign Language (3 years recommended)
- 1 year college prep Visual Performing Art
- 1 additional year of College Prep Class
- Must take the SAT and/or ACT
- 3.0 GPA (CSU)
- 3.6 GPA (UC)



### College Entrance Exams

SAT

- SAT: Scholastics Aptitude Test
- ACT: American College Testing
- Take the PSAT/NMSQT test in 8<sup>th</sup> grade (also available in 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> grade)
  - This test is a great way to practice your test taking skills before taking the SAT during your Junior year
  - Entered into the National Merit Scholarship program when taken during Junior year
- "The Edge" is a test prep session for seniors (fall semester) & juniors (spring semester)
- www.khanacademy.org is a FREE tutorial website for academics, PSAT, and SAT test prep
