TRANSFER AT A GLANCE

- Guaranteed Admission to 35 participating Historically Black Colleges and Universities
- Priority consideration for housing
- Preadmission advising
- Acceptance of completed transfer credit
- Apply up to 4 colleges and/or universities for free



PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

Students must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Attend a CA Community College
- Complete 30 transferable UC/CSU credits
- 2.5 GPA or higher

OR

- Complete transfer-level associate degree (60 credits +) at a CA Community College
- 2.5 GPA or higher
- Must Complete Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) or the California State University General Education Breadth (CSU GE)

- Research participating institutions
 - Visit website
www.cccco.edu/hbcutransfer
 - Ask questions
 - Attend HBCU events
- Develop a Student Education Plan
- Meet with a counselor regularly
- Complete student verification with counselor
- Receive fee waiver when ready to apply for transfer
