unweighted grade point average  
and maintain it during  
membership.

# SCHOLARSHIP

List the semesters you have been involved in:

- CSF
- Any awards you have received while in high school
  - Academic competitions
  - Honor Roll
  - Athletic
  - Performance (Band, Choir, Drama, Forensics, FFA.....)

Do not include AP classes taken and tests passed on the Scholarship page.

# CHARACTER

In this section list any clubs, sports teams, or organizations both at school and outside of school you are involved in.

# LEADERSHIP

Leadership experiences can be drawn from school and community activities while working with or for others.



# LEADERSHIP-Examples

- Youth group leader
- Soccer Referee
- Vacation Bible School Teacher
- Team Captain
- Cross Age Tutor
- Class or Club Officer
- Committee Chairperson
- Newspaper/Yearbook Contributor

Must show diversity within leadership activities.

# SERVICE

In this section you will be asked to list both School and Community Service that you have completed or are currently participating in.

For service, if all of your service events are required events for a particular class such as Leadership, you will not score well on the scoring rubric. You must go above and beyond what is required.

# ADDITIONAL NOTES

- Don't mark semesters that haven't occurred yet.
- In other words, if you're a junior, don't mark any boxes on second semester junior year.
- Only things completed or currently in progress count towards membership.

Some organizations may appear more than once on your application.

For example, you may have CSF listed on your Scholarship page, but you may also have it listed on the Leadership page if you were an officer in CSF.

In general though things should appear in only one category.

# Application Pointers

- There are directions and examples on the top of each page of the application to assist you in what to put in each category.
- You want to make your application look balanced. Pages DO NOT have to be full to qualify, but a blank page will disqualify your application.

# When is the application due?

- Forms will be accepted NO LATER than 11:59 pm on Sunday, October 29th. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Application workshops will be held. See the dates and times posted on the NHS Google Classroom New member application post.
