Sophomore Year Checklist

Pass ALL classes with a "C" or better to remain "A-G" eligible and have less summer school to attend.

Make sure you're on track for graduation and keep your grades up!

- Review transcripts at least twice per year.
- Learn how to calculate your GPA.
- Are you on track with your credits?
 - You should have at least 50 credits at this time.
- Are you on track with CUSD subject requirements?
- Are you on track to meet "A - G" requirements?
- Are there classes you need to retake to meet graduation and/or A-G requirements?
- Ask teachers for help and attend intervention labs during lunch and after school for more help and support.

Check Student Connect often & make sure you join Class of 2025 Google Classroom!

Bookmark Student Connect on your laptop, computer, and/or smart phone and log in daily! Check to see if all assignments have been turned in and credit has been given. It is also very important to check your student email often for important information from your teachers, counselor, and the school.

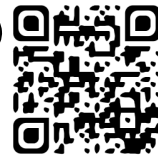
